## General conditions: Research Associates (RA) and Junior Research Fellow (JRF),:

- Professionals with requisite qualifications and experience as prescribed would be eligible for being engaged as RA and JRF. However, if suitable NET/GATE qualified candidates are not found, the candidates without these qualifications may be considered but as per the DST approved rates.
- 2. R.A. & JRF would be engaged for a fixed period for providing high quality services to the Institute or for attending to specific and time-bound jobs.
- 3. The appointment of RA & JRF would be on Full-time basis and they would not be permitted to take up any other assignment during the project period.
- 4. The appointment of RA and JRF is purely temporary on co-terminus basis and do not entitle the appointee to any claim implicit or explicit or any NIH post. The appointment can be cancelled at any time by the Institute without assigning any reason.
- 5. The initial term of appointment and subsequent extension (s) if any, shall be decided on case to case basis depending upon the specific job and the time frame for its completion.

- 6. The RA and JRF shall not be entitled to any allowance such as Dearness Allowance, Residential Telephone, Transport facility, Personal Staff etc.
- 7. The RA and JRF may be provided with the transit accommodation as per prevailing rules of the Institute. The applicable licence fee shall be charged and the RA and JRF shall vacate the accommodation on the termination or expiry of the tenure, whichever is earlier.
- 8. No TA/DA shall be admissible for joining the appointment on contractual basis. RA and JRF shall be allowed TA/DA for their travel inside the country in connection with the official work.
- The selection of candidates will be made through Walk-in-Interview. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidate for attending the interview.
- 10. Candidates can directly attend the walk-in-interview on the prescribed date, time, and place at NIH along with complete bio-data, passport size photograph and original proof of qualification and experience. They must also bring with them self-attested copies of their certificates. Candidate may report in NIH in 0:30 hours before Interview time. After starting of Interview, admission in the same will not be allowed.
