GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Age limit for the position is **28 years** but age relaxation will be considered as per Government of India norms for reserved category candidates.

The candidates appearing for Written Exam should report at Wildlife Institute of India (WII), Chandrabani, Dehradun, Uttarakhand, with original application and documents at **0930 hours on 16 August 2019** for scrutiny of documents followed by Written Examination on the same day at 1030 hours. Result of the written exam would be announced at 1300 hours and shortlisted candidates would be interviewed from 1400 hours onwards.

Application should be duly filled in the prescribed format, duly signed and should be accompanied by self-attested copies of documents on educational qualifications, research experience, UGC/CSIR/GATE certificate (if any), extracurricular activities, date of birth, mark sheets of all examinations, community certificate (if sought relaxation as per Government of India rules), etc.
4. The Institute will not provide accommodation for candidates appearing for the written exam and personal interview. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the written exam and personal interview.
5. At the time of the verification of original documents or even after selection, if it is found that an attempt has been made by the applicant to willfully conceal, misrepresent or canvass the facts, such applicant will not be considered for selection and due action will be taken.
