(e)	Crucial date	The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the last date of receipt of application.
(f)	Closing date	The closing date will be 45 days from the date of publication of the advertisement in Employment News/Rozgar Samachar/Local Daily Newspaper . In respect of North East region, i.e Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti Division of Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep will be 52 days .

2. **Scheme of Examination.** The selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit. The selection process will comprise of written test and skill test wherever necessary. Final merit will be decided on the basis of marks obtained in the written test and skill tests wherever applicable. **Continued on page 11**

The question papers of Written Test will be bilingual i.e. English and Hindi. However, the questions on the portion of English Language subject will be in English only.

Syllabus for Examination.

3. General Intelligence. The question will be of 10th standard and would include questions of non-verbal type. The test may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, figure classification arithmetical number series, non-verbal series. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, arithmetical computation and other analytical functions.

4. General Awareness. The questions will be of 10th standard. The questions will be designed to test the ability of candidate's general awareness of the environment around him/her and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of 10th standard educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic Science, General Polity including Indian Constitution, and Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline.

5. Numerical Aptitude. This paper will include questions on problems relating to Number systems, Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals and Fractions and relationship between Numbers, Fundamental Arithmetical Operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, use of Table and Graphs, Mensuration, Time and Distance, Ratio and Time, Time and work etc.

6. English Language. The questions will be of 10th standard. Candidate's understanding the Basics of English Language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage, etc his/her writing ability would also be tested.

Important Instructions to the Candidates/Applicants

7. Dates of examinations will be intimated to the eligible candidates later on.

8. Candidates appearing for written test and skill test will travel on their own expenses. However, SC/ST candidates will be paid traveling allowance of second class (2nd Class) railway/bus fare as per rules for onward and return journey performed by shortest route provided the distance traveled is more than 30 Kms on production of journey details as well as railway receipt/bus fare tickets.

9. Persons working in Central/State Govt/PSU must apply through proper channel along with the certificate from their establishment that no disciplinary action is contemplated/pending against them and that they have no objection in releasing them in case of selection.

10. New entrants to Government Service, entering on or after 01 Jan 2004 are governed by the New Defined Contribution Pension System (known as New Pension Scheme).

11. The Commandant, RIMC shall not be responsible for any postal delay or failure.

12. **The Commandant, RIMC reserves the right to change the number of vacancies and decide on the percentage of minimum qualifying marks to be obtained in written test of each trade which will qualify the candidate for appearing for the concerned trade test in which he had applied for. "**

13. If the number of applications received in response to the advertisement is large and it will not be convenient or possible to arrange the examination for all the candidates, **The Commandant, RIMC reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates to a reasonable limit on the basis of either percentage of marks obtained in the prescribed minimum essential qualifications or desirable qualifications or qualifications higher than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement or experience.** Therefore, the candidates should mention all the qualifications over and above the minimum qualification and should attach self attested copies of the certificates in support thereof.

15. Ex-servicemen certificate should have been issued by the Competent Authorities. A copy of Discharge Certificate should also be enclosed.

16. The Ex-servicemen candidate applying for the post under ex-servicemen category should also have to give an Undertaking in the format given below as **Appendix-I**.

17. Candidates applying against a reserved post must enclose supportive documents viz caste certificate, disability certificate, non-creamy layer certificate in case of OBC etc in support of their claim of belonging to the reserved category. Self attested copies of certificates in support of Educational Qualification/ Technical Qualification, Experience, caste, date of birth, PH and ex-servicemen are to be enclosed with the application.

18. Incomplete or unsigned application and without Left/Right Thumb Impression or applications not accompanied by attested copies of certificates or application received at RIMC, Dehradun after the last date of receipt of application or without two additional photographs duly self-attested (on front side) will be summarily rejected and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

19. The applications can be filled by the candidates either in English or Hindi.
